Sammy Davis Jr

His nickname was 'Mr. Show Business', but Sammy Davis Jr. fondly called himself 'the only Black, Puerto Rican, one-eyed, Jewish entertainer in the world'.

Although he stood at a mere 5'6" and weighed only 120 pounds, Davis' 60 year long career left a massive impression on the entertainment world.

Dean Martin

Dean Martin was an American singer, actor and comedian of Italian descent.

One of the most popular and enduring American entertainers of the mid-20th century, Martin was nicknamed 'The King of Cool'.

Frank Sinatra

Francis Albert Sinatra was an American singer and actor.

Nicknamed the 'Chairman of the Board', Sinatra is considered one of the most popular entertainers of the 1940s, 1950s and 1960s. He is among the world's best-selling music artists, having sold an estimated 150 million records.

Peter Lawford

Peter Sydney Ernest Lawford was an English actor.

He resided in the United States throughout his adult life.

He was a member of the 'Rat Pack' and the brother-in-law of US president John F. Kennedy and senators Robert F. Kennedy and Edward Kennedy.

Joey Bishop

Joseph Abraham Gottlieb, known professionally as Joey Bishop, was an American entertainer who appeared on television as early as 1948 and eventually starred in his own weekly comedy series playing a talk/variety show host, then later hosted a late night talk show with Regis Philbin as his young sidekick on ABC.
